PREFACE

EIA XVIII 2019 Speech Competition is open for all students on university level in Indonesia with 40 participants as the maximum limit. In this Speech competition, participants will be delivering their own written speech, based on selected themes given by the committee. The scoring criteria of this competition are **Matters** (originality and speech substances), **Performance** (intonation, attire and neatness, punctuality of time, and way of delivering the speech itself), and **English Ability** (vocabulary, grammar, and pronunciation).

PURPOSES

Giving a chance for all varsity students throughout Indonesia to compete and improve their English ability and skill, giving an opportunity for all participants to do deep understanding and research about the subject for every theme given, building critical and solutive mindset that a varsity students should have toward issues in life, and forming a competitive atmosphere for all participants.

COMPETITION SEQUENCES

Speech Competition is divided into 3 (three) rounds which are:

1. Preliminary Round
10 (ten) participants with the highest score will go to the semi-final round.
2. Semi-Final Round; and
5 (five) participants with the highest score will go to the final round.
3. Final Round.

The winner of this competition will be determined based on the results of this round.

GENERAL RULES

1. The participants of speech competition must be **Varsity Students**.
2. The committee of EIA XVIII (2019) **will not provide any refund** for those who are quitting the competition or disqualified for any reason.
3. To be eligible to compete, the participant must:
 - Enrolled in a University by showing the Student ID Card at the time of registration.
 - Have completed the payment of registration fee.
4. Participants is allowed to book and keep slot first within 3 days only. Every participants **must** be registered online on bit.ly/eecinaction2019 at the maximum

5. Every participant who has registered online must re-register themselves and attend Technical Meeting on **Monday, July 8th, 2019**. Participants who are not able to re-register and attend Technical Meeting **MUST** send their permission for absence to the committee through Tika Larasati (082176623991 / LINE ID : tikaav) or Rahma Suci (082280094579 / LINE ID: Uciss). The permission for absence must be due to personal urgencies or reasons of which the committee found acceptable. Participants or the representatives who do not attend Technical Meeting without any confirmation must accept the result of Technical Meeting's discussion; no objection will be accepted by the committee.
6. The participations who have been registered online can be **replaced** with a new participant but it can be allowed **ONLY** in the same branch competition, **at the latest on Friday, June 28th, 2019** by sending the request of replacement to EIA XVIII (2019) Speech Competition's e-mail address : SpeechEIA@gmail.com, with the following subject: Replacement_(Speech Competition) and the following format body mail :
 - a. Competition Type : Speech Competition
 - b. Name of Original Participant :
 - c. Name of Replacement Participant :
 - d. Name for Certificate :
 - e. Reason :

Any kind of related document that supports the participant's reason must be attached within the email (e.g. signed medical permit from hospital, participant can send the document in an image form/PDF form). If the committee finds the reason as an acceptable reason, then the committee will send the approval of replacement request to the participant's e-mail address.

7. After **Friday, June 28th, 2019** replacement of participants are not allowed and if it happens, the participants will be disqualified.
8. All participants **must** re-register themselves on **Monday, July 8th, 2019**. The registered names that will be the named printed on the certificates are based on the

re-registration's absence. All participants **should** check spelling of their own name whether it's correct or not. After **Monday, July 8th, 2019**, the committees are not responsible for any mistakes and misspelling.

9. The participants must attend the Opening Ceremony on **Tuesday, July 9th, 2019** and **wear** their own university's almamater.
10. The speech must be originally made by the participant. Any quote is allowed during the performances but should not be the major content.
11. During the competitions, the registered participants cannot be represented by anything else, participation by audio, video, and/or teleconference is strictly prohibited, otherwise will be **disqualified**.
12. Video recording and/or taking pictures are allowed during any of the participant's performance **without flash**.
13. Every **communication device must be silenced or turned off** at the competition venue, unless permitted by the committee and written in Rules and Regulations.
14. The participants must respect and appreciate every judgement from the adjudicators. **The judges' decisions are final and can not be contested**.
15. The certificates, the prize, and the trophy can be taken **ONLY** in the closing ceremony on **Thursday, July 11st, 2019** by the participants or the **representative**.
16. Participants are permitted to take certificate until **Wednesday, July 31st, 2019**.
17. Every rule must be followed. Disqualification is necessary for any participant who violates the rule.

TECHNICAL MEETING

1. Every participant or representative **must** attend the Technical Meeting on **Monday, July 8th, 2019**.
2. The Technical Meeting will be the platform for discussion about the rules that will be the basis for the competition.
3. Only the committee who can decide whether a rule needs to be changed or not.
4. Results of the Technical Meeting are considered accepted and legitimated by the

participants and no objection later will be accepted by the committee.

5. The participants and/or representatives who are not able to attend the Technical Meeting due to personal urgencies or for any reason must accept the result of Technical Meeting's discussion; no objection will be accepted by the committee.
6. The participants and/or representatives should wear polite and appropriate clothes and shoes.

RULES OF THE VENUE

1. The participants must not wear sandals, shorts and/or t-shirt at the premises of the competition. The participants must wear shoes, collared shirt and pants, unless participants have compelling and necessitate conditions (e.g. participant get injured and he/she must use sandals, etc).
2. The participants must keep his/her appearance neat and clean.
3. The participants are not allowed to smoke/use vape/other addictive substances in Faculty of Economics and Business area.
4. Littering is also prohibited, please keep the venue nice and clean and throw away rubbish in rubbish bin.
5. Do not bring any illegal substances or materials, such as illegal drugs and/or weapons especially ones that might cause harm to the other participants.

SPECTATORS

1. Participants are allowed to bring spectators.
2. Spectators are not allowed to distract any performances in any form:
 - a. Any person or persons **should not enter or leave** the competition venue **when a participant is performing**.
 - b. All spectators must behave in good morale and manners. Inappropriate cheers are not allowed. Note: applause is only allowed **after** every performance.
3. All participants and spectators must be silent when another participant is delivering their speech. For participants who violate this rule will be given a warning from the committee.

4. Spectators who violate this rule will be expelled from the competition venue.

RULES DURING THE COMPETITION

1. The participants **must** come at least 30 minutes before the competition begun.
2. During performances, participants and/or spectators are not allowed to distract participants' performances in any form (e.g. coming in or out from the venue during performance, inappropriate cheers are not allowed, laughing or talking loudly, using cameras with flash, sounds from cellphones, etc.)
3. Coach, lecturers, and/or spectators **MUST NOT** provide help, assistance and/or answers in any way during making their case, or during the performance to the participants and are only allowed to watch performances.
4. If the participants are caught cheating with coach, lecturers, and/or spectators, the committee are entitled to unilaterally decides to disqualify participants from the competition.
5. If there are technical difficulties (such as power failure or broken equipment) or should any problems arise during the performance of the participants, which is no participants' fault, then the committee might allow a restart with the discretion of the committee with the approval of the judges.
6. The participants will be **called three times** in a row based on their turn to perform (first chance)
7. Participant who doesn't show up at the first call, three times in a row (first chance) will be called on the last turn (second chance).
8. Participants who don't come on the second chance will be **DISQUALIFIED**.

RULES WHILE PERFORMING

1. Upon being introduced, the participant shall proceed immediately to the speaking position. Timing will begin with the participant's first definite verbal or nonverbal communication with the audience, such as a sound, a staged act, etc.
2. When the participants make mistakes when performing, the committee **does not** compromise and/or allow any pauses of duration nor provide any restart for the

participants.

3. There will be displayed timer in projector and also time keeper will provide warning signals by showing colored flags as followed:
 - **Green Flag** as a sign that the participants already used 3 minutes.
 - **Yellow Flag** as a sign that the participants already used 5 minutes.
 - **Red Flag** as a sign that the participants already used 7 minutes.
 - **Black Flag** as a sign that the time is up.
4. Participants are allowed to use a small and non-dangerous property (e.g. pen, paper, or picture) during the performance, but should not be the main focus of the speech.
5. Participants **must not** use any slang words while delivering speech. Using slang words will reduce participant's point.

SPECIFIC RULES

ROUNDS:

PRELIMINARY ROUND: PREPARED SPEECH

1. Preliminary Round will be held on **Tuesday, July 9th, 2019**. In this round, participants will deliver their speech which has been prepared (typed and printed out) before the competition begin with their chosen theme from the ones given by the committee.
2. The theme for Preliminary Round will be :
"Explore Beyond Your Horizon : Spirit of Youth Changes Mindset of The World"
3. The participants must submit **hardcopy** and **softcopy** of their speech text. The participants must **submit 4 hardcopies** for Preliminary Round of their speech on **Monday, July 8th, 2019**. The committee does not provide printing service. **Softcopy** of the speech should be sent through EIA XVIII (2019) Speech Competition's e-mail address: SpeechEIA@gmail.com at the latest **Sunday, July 7th, 2019**, with the following subject: Softcopy_(Speech Competition)_(Name of

4. The participants must attach the following format in the header of the speech text :

5. All softcopies of the speech must be in PDF form and name of the file is as followed: **Name of the Participant_Round of Competition_Title of The Speech** (e.g. *Annisa Fitri_Preliminary Round_The Positive Impact of Reading*).
6. The minimum duration of each participant's performance is **5 minutes** and the maximum duration is **7 minutes with extra 30 seconds to end the speech**. Disobeying the duration of the performance will decrease 5 points for every 30 seconds. Points will be deducted if a participant performs the speech less than 5 minutes or more than 7 minutes and 30 seconds. There will be 5 (five) points deduction for every exceeding 30 (thirty) seconds and 5 (five) points deduction for undertime performances per 30 (thirty) seconds.
7. The participants should not bring and read the text when performing.
8. There is no question from the adjudicator in this round.
9. Committee will inform the name of 10 (ten) participants who are eligible to run for the Semi Final Round. After that, committee will also announce the theme for Final Round.

SEMI FINAL ROUND: IMPROMPTU

1. Semi-final Round is held on **Wednesday, July 10th, 2019**. In this round, all competing participants are not allowed to bring any prepared speech text or outlines to the competition venue for this round as we will be having **impromptu session**. All participants **must bring their own black/blue pen**. The committee will only provide the paper.

- Participants will deliver the speech that they will be making on the day of the round. Participants are allowed to pick 1 (one) from 5 (five) themes that will be given by the committees.
- The committees do not compromise with all of the lateness. If it happened, he/she will be disqualified.
- All participants' belongings will be put in front of the classroom; all will be monitored by the committee.
- Any form of cheating caught and/or reported to the committee may cause **disqualification** with the discretion of the committee.
- The participant **only permitted to bring pen and cellphone** in the quarantine room, the committee will provide a note for each participant.
- The time for creating speech is **10 minutes which includes preparation**.
- The minimum duration of each participant's performance is **4 minutes** and the maximum duration is **6 minutes with extra 30 seconds to end the speech**. Disobeying the duration of the performance will decrease 5 points for every 30 seconds. Points will be deducted if a participant performs the speech less than 4 minutes or more than 6 minutes and 30 seconds. There will be 5 (five) points deduction for every exceeding 30 (thirty) seconds and 5 (five) points deduction for undertime performances per 30 (thirty) seconds.
- The participants are allowed to bring the note when performing.
- There will be 5 minutes additional time for adjudicators to give their opinion and **1 (one) question to each participant**.
- The participants have to answer the question asked by the adjudicator. **The duration of answering** the question is maximal **3 (three) minutes without extra additional**.
- Committee will inform the name of 5 (five) participants who are eligible to run for the final round.

FINAL ROUND: PREPARED SPEECH

- Final Round is held on **Wednesday, July 10th, 2019** after Semi-Final has been

held. In this round participants will deliver the speech that they have made before the competition with the subject that will be announced after Preliminary Round on **Tuesday, July 9th, 2019.**

2. Participants will deliver the speech that they will be making one day before. Participants are allowed to pick 1 (one) from 3 (three) themes that will be given by the committees.
3. The participants should prepare **4 hardcopies** of their speech and submit them to the committee **from the beginning of day (Wednesday, July 10th, 2019).** The participants must attach the following format in the header of the text :
 - a. Name of participant :
 - b. Round of the competition : Final Round
 - c. Title of the speech :
4. The minimum duration of each participant's performance is **5 minutes** and the maximum duration is **7 minutes with extra 30 seconds to end the speech.** Disobeying the duration of the performance will decrease 5 points for every 30 seconds. Points will be deducted if a participant performs the speech less than 5 minutes or more than 7 minutes and 30 seconds. There will be 5 (five) points deduction for every exceeding 30 (thirty) seconds and 5 (five) points deduction for undertime performances per 30 (thirty) seconds.
5. The participants are allowed to bring a note (but no paper) when performing.
6. There will be 5 minutes additional time for adjudicators to give their opinion and maximum **3 (three) questions to each participant.**
7. The participants have to answer the questions asked by the adjudicators. The duration of answering a question is maximum **3 (three) minutes without extra additional.**
8. The winners of speech competition will be announced after **closing ceremony (Thursday, July 11st, 2019).** The committee will inform the name of 3 (three) participants who win EIA XVIII 2019 as the first, second, and third winner.

1. Speech themes for Preliminary Round is "*Explore Beyond Your Horizon : Spirit of Youth Changes Mindset of The World*"
2. Speech themes for Semi-Final Round will be given on **Wednesday, July 10th, 2019**.
3. Speech themes for Final Round will be given on **Tuesday, July 9th, 2019** (after Top 10 Announcement)
4. Subjects outside of the given themes are not permitted. Competing participants are allowed to explore and research in depth to construct their speech.

SCORING ASPECTS

a. Matter (35%)

- **Innovative** **15%**
Participants' innovations on giving their speech is scored
- **Speech Substances** **20%**
Solution of the speech should be concrete. SMART criteria (Specific, Measurable, Achievable, Realistic, Time Bound) of the speech is measured.

b. Performance (45%)

- **Clarity** **10%**
This point is about how clear participants give their speech point to the audiences.
- **Body Language and Expression** **15%**
Participants' body language and expression of the speech are scored.
- **Intonation** **10%**
Participants' intonation of the speech is scored.
- **Appearance** **5%**
Participants' appearance while delivering speech is scored.
- **Manner** **5%**
Participants' manner while delivering speech is scored.

c. English Ability (20%)
